APPLICATION SUMMARY:

The subject property, known as Block 14303, Lot 2 is located at 95 Greene St. The property is approximately 30,120 SF in size and located within the mixed-use district of the Colgate Redevelopment Plan ("the Redevelopment Plan") area of the City of Jersey City. The property is improved with an eight (8) story mixed-use building. In anticipation of a new tenant in the building, 95 Greene, LLC ("the applicant") seeks minor site plan approval to create a new entranceway on York St. and eight (8) new flush-mounted signs.

- 3) Architect of record, Spagnolo Gisness & Associates, Inc., shall submit a signed and sealed affidavit confirming that the signage was constructed as approved.
