After reviewing architectural plans entitled "Existing Building Restoration 75 Vroom Street Jersey City Hudson County, NJ" prepared by Weckenmann Architecture (undated), HPC Staff finds that the proposed project conforms with the Secretary of the Interior Standards for Rehabilitation. HPC Staff does not anticipate any adverse effects to the historic resource or surrounding historic resources as a consequence of the proposed work.

HPC Staff recommends the planning board adopt the following conditions related to this work:

- 1. If there are any changes to the project, the applicant shall notify HPC Staff of the proposed changes and provide updated architectural plans for review and approval.
- 2. All proposed paint colors shall be contextual for the age and architectural style of the building. HPC Staff may review these colors but is not required to.
- 3. Any replacement architectural elements, such as window lintels or cornice brackets, shall match the historic site evidence in terms of profile, dimension, detail, material, and finish.
