PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on March 25, 2021, at 6:30 P.M., a public hearing will be held by the Jersey City Zoning Board of Adjustment regarding the application of Mina Melek & Atef Naguib (the "Applicant"), under Case number Z20-080, for the property located at 241 Clinton Avenue, Block 18303, Lot 10, Jersey City, New Jersey (the "Property") in an R-1 zone within Ward B.
